Campaigning and Lobbying

The Committee Members and officers of EHRA are involved in campaigning and lobbying at all political levels.

Service Improvement

Each EHRA member benchmarks against performance. The aim is to improve service delivery through performance monitoring. EHRA members continue to perform better than larger housing associations

Partnership

EHRA work in partnership with partner agencies to deliver job clubs, welfare rights and apprentice opportunities.

Employment and Training for Local People

EHRA works in partnership to provide employment opportunities including opportunities for Housing Apprentices and access to formal qualifications (HNC Working with Communities/Housing). A jobs club service is provided to EHRA members.

Poverty

EHRA has developed a Poverty Charter and works in partnership to promote credit unions and provides welfare rights services throughout the local communities.

Training and Support

EHRA provides an annual programme of training for staff and committee.
